PARLIAMENTARY BOUNDARY CHANGES PROPOSED

SEPTEMBER 2016

The Boundary Commission has issued its report on new constituencies reducing the number of MPS in each area. Wales is to have 11 less under the proposals.

In particular, Montgomeryshire is broken up forming two new constituencies but joining with others.

The plan below shows in green the existing Montgomeryshire constituency and in Red and Blue the two new constituencies. Welshpool is in the Red Area and is included in such places as Llangollen.

There is a consultation to take place over the next 12 weeks and if anyone wishes to put forward a view they should do so to the Boundary Commission at Hastings House, Fitzalan Court Cardiff CF24 0BL or email bcomm.wales@wales.gov.uk

Welshpool Town Council will consider the proposals later in September.
