

## WELSHPOOL AND LLANFAIR LIGHT RAILWAY TRAIL COMPLETE



In the last few years we have seen the clearing of the WLLR transfer station and the creation of the sculptures by the Tourist Information Centre. These were part of an overall plan which included a Town Trail which has been designed and organised by Alan Crowe. The trail comprises 13 information boards located along the line as it would have passed through Welshpool in the past. There is also a scanning option at each board which will let people see a DVD of the railway line in action as it would have been at that actual location.

The Town Council erected the boards and will now look after them.

A short ceremony took place on Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> September 2016 with Deputy Mayor Cllr Hazel Evans, Russell George (AM), Cllr Estelle Bleivas, Robert Robinson Town Clerk, Alan Crowe, Steve Clews & Mike Lister from the WLLR and other interest people on the day.

The Deputy Mayor Cllr Hazel Evans unveiled the last map with Alan Crowe.

It is hoped that local people and tourists alike will follow the train discovering the old route of the Welshpool and Llanfair Light Railway.
