### **Westwood Day Centre to be named in memory of Ann Holloway**

Welshpool Town Council is to rename the Day Centre near Welshpool Hospital to 'The Ann Holloway Centre' in her memory and in recognition of her work to the community of Welshpool over many decades. Ann often used to visit the centre and took a keen interest in its life. She was also a great supporter of the Town Council taking over the service to ensure it remained for the residents of Welshpool.

The main entrance and entrance hall is due to be redecorated soon and at that time the signage will change to the centre's new name and image.

The Centre provides day care for those who need support during the hours of approx 9am though to 4pm weekdays. The centre has recently seen its main room redecorated and a new conservatory added to improve facilities even more.

Care is provided by enthusiastic trained staff who are always prepared to 'go the extra mile' to ensure that all those who attend have a great experience.

There are approx. 24 Clients most days with a reduced number on Fridays which is a special day for those with dementia. There is a range of activities on offer with lunch cooked in the kitchens on site to a very high standard.

The Council also operates a Meals on Wheels service from the centre as well.
