BURGESSES' LAND SMALL GRANTS SCHEME

The Charity has decided to run a small grants scheme again in 2017. The scheme is for groups supporting the young, disabled and elderly people living in the area covered by the Charity.

If you are involved in a group which is for the young, elderly or people with disabilities and you operate in the areas of Welshpool, Trewern, Guilsfield and Castle Caereinion this small grants scheme might be for you.

Applications are made by means of a form available by contacting the Trust as described below.

Applications will be assessed on the following basis:

The group must benefit inhabitants of either Welshpool, Trewern, Guilsfield or Castle Caereinion. Where there are people in the group who live outside the area, these must not exceed 30% of the group members. The group should be working with young people, people with disabilities or the elderly. A grant can be used for running costs, including room hire and / or items of equipment. The grants will normally be limited to a maximum of £500. An award will take the form of a single payment.

Funds are very limited and priority will be given to groups who have not previously received an award from the Trust.

Applications must be with the Trust no later than 3 April 2017.
